



THE PUNJAB SCHOOL ADMISSION TO CLASS III

This is for the information of the parents that a few vacancies for admission to the class arise due to transfers and posting of parents to other cities or for some other personal reasons. These are purely merit-based admissions.

Admissions to these vacancies are finalized on the basis of the results of the written examination in the subjects of English, Urdu and Mathematics and a subsequent interview. An oral test for Quran is conducted separately.

Syllabi for the written examination are as follows.

- Identification and use of noun, verb, adjective, adverb, pronoun
- punctuation, rhyming words, articles, this/that, these/those, has, have, do, does
- Sentence Making,
- Comprehension Passage
- Composition writing. 10 sentences (Seasons, Animals, Personalities)
- Reading

- Writing
- Present and Past Continuous

*Numbers to 10, 000, *Place value of numbers. Comparing and ordering of numbers up to 10, 000, *Addition subtraction within 10, 000, * Conversion of length m to cm, cm to m, km to m, m to km conversion of kg to g and g to kg, *Multiplying by 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, *Division by 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, *Adding and subtracting money, *Volume in millilitres, *Volume in litres and millilitres, *Angle, right angles.
